Inhabiting southwest Botswana, the Bakgalagadi (BAH-kah-lah-HAH-dee) may be one of the most overlooked and neglected people groups in Southern Africa. Located in and around the Kalahari Desert, their sheer isolation makes them a people unreached. However, God has a plan for “the people of the great thirst land,” as their name translates. Current efforts are underway for Scripture translation in Sekgalagadi, the language of the Bakgalagadi. A few believers are being trained in disciple-making skills so they can go out and share among the Bakgalagadi.

- Pray that God would bless the efforts being made to reach the 42,000 Bakgalagadi people of Botswana.
- Ask God to multiply the results of those few who have committed to reach the Bakgalagadi, that He may bring forth a harvest of righteousness in the desert.
- Zionism, a cult-like religion many mistake as Christianity, is present in many communities. Pray the hearts of the Bakgalagadi will understand the difference between truth and falsehood.
- As Bakgalagadi hear and accept the Gospel, pray for discipleship to take place so that the seeds of truth would produce lives of faith.
- Ask God to send more workers to the Bakgalagadi harvest.
