“We are beginning to trust you now.” These are words from a Fulbe (FUL-bay) villager after God enabled missionaries to find help for one, ostracized by her family and village, needing a grapefruit-sized tumor removed from her mouth. “The curse has been removed!” – this from others in the remote village in Guinea where the Gospel has never penetrated. IMB personnel had been working in this area for several years; this was the first breakthrough.

- Pray for the Holy Spirit to fall with power on missionaries ministering among the Fulbe, who live in the bondage of charms, talismans and the manipulation of the spirit world.
- Pray for courage to reign in the hearts of Fulbe believers, who face persecution from family and community in a people group of over 2.5 million with 99.9% professing Islam.
- Pray for protection for missionaries and believers as militant fundamentalist factions spring up, drawing the Fulbe to a stricter Islam.
- Even in persecution God is moving. Pray that the small groups of three and four coming together wanting to hear more about this God who loves and cares will be moved to conviction, trust and commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ.
