The 2001 edition of "Operation World" states, "There are more unreached peoples in Chad than in any other African country." Despite the "Chad for Christ" campaign in the 1990s this statement still stands. The Gor (GORE) are one of these unreached groups. Living along the southwest border with the Central African Republic, the Gor live an impoverished lifestyle. Government health centers have not operated since the war in 1979, and less than half of Gor villages have access to safe drinking water. While there is some Scripture available, illiteracy rates are high, with only 10 percent able to read and write. Islamic influence is on the rise in urban areas and among the Chadian government. Even so, the Gor are receptive to the Gospel message.

- Praise God for religious freedom present in Chad today.
- Pray for the production of audio recordings enabling the Gor to clearly hear the Gospel.
- Ask God to give believers wisdom in developing holistic projects addressing the physical and spiritual needs among the 110,000 Gor in Chad.
- As God calls, pray for obedience among those He chooses to send to the Gor.
- Praise God for receptive hearts; pray for Gor believers to share Christ with their neighbors.
