A First World city on a Third World continent, Johannesburg, South Africa is not only a major city in Sub-Saharan Africa and host of the 2010 soccer World Cup, but also one of the world's leading financial centers. With 52 murders each day, 200,000 robberies, 55,000 rapes and 500,000 cases of assault and attempted murder reported in South Africa each year, it looks as though Johannesburg is a city in need of a Savior. As with most major cities, there is a church available for almost any faith. However, the salvation story is being drowned out by the din of urbanization and the pursuit of worldly pleasure and gain.

- Pray for revival in the churches of Johannesburg, that believers' hearts would burn to share the Gospel message.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit to move among the 10,267,700 residents of Greater Johannesburg, that they would recognize their need for a Savior.
- South Africa has more people with HIV/AIDS than any other country in the world (approximately 5.7 million by 2007 estimates). Pray for believers to address this issue biblically. Pray that people will have a lifestyle change.
- Pray that believers will always be ready with a word of witness.
