Research indicates there are over 131,000 Maxi (Max-ee) people farming millet, maize, rice and cocoa in Benin. However, information about them is scarce. It is known that, country-wide, Benin has few believers. There is no written Scripture, no JESUS film, and no evangelical radio broadcasts targeting the Maxi. The fact that God loves them is certain. We know there will be Maxi believers around the throne. Revelation 7:9-10 describes a multitude from every nation, tribe, people and language before the throne and in front of the Lamb. God has given His people a mandate to “ask the Lord of the Harvest, therefore, to send out workers into the harvest field” (Matthew 9:38, NIV). Does this include the Maxi people? Yes!

- Pray for creative storytellers who will go share the Good News with the Maxi in terms they can understand.
- Pray for a softening of Maxi hearts as God prepares the soil for the seeds of the Gospel.
- Pray for abundant watering through the Holy Spirit to bring these seeds to faith.
- Pray for harvesters to come to Benin ready to share the Gospel and train believers so that none will fall away.
