Nairobi, the “Green City in the Sun,” boasts of her stock exchange, her universities and hospitals, the international companies and organizations she hosts, and the game reserve with lions and giraffes along her southern border. Nairobi is proud of her 3.5 million multicultural residents, which includes Kenya’s 42 people groups and tens of thousands of guests from across the world, the majority from neighboring countries facing problems. Nairobi does not boast of her large slums lacking basic necessities, home to an estimated 50 percent of her population, or of the estimated 60,000 children living on her streets.

- An estimated 45 percent of the people in Nairobi are Protestants, yet only 12 percent attend church. Pray that the Christians of Nairobi will be disciplined and led by leaders who truthfully teach God’s promises and truths.
- Tribalism remains a divider in Nairobi. Pray for unity among Christians.
- Pray for physical strength and spiritual wisdom for those sharing the Good News with the residents of Nairobi’s slums.
- Pray that Nairobi Christians will be strong ambassadors of their Father’s love and salvation. Pray especially that refugees and other guests from countries without religious freedom will learn of the true God while living in Nairobi.
