After taking up the challenge to learn a Bible story and retell it, Wa desired to learn more stories. She now has a group of ladies meeting in her yard each week to learn more stories from God's Word. * Update – Wa has accepted Christ and is now sharing the Jesus Road with her Duun neighbors!

- Pray that the Holy Spirit would confront the Duun with their sin, preparing their hearts for Gospel encounters.
- Pray for a breakthrough of belief for the over 120,000 Duun living in Mali.
- Ask God to send more workers to the fields of Mali.
