Reaching the whole world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ is a monumental task. A researcher went online to find information on the Seba (SEH-bah) people of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The Joshua Project, a research initiative seeking to highlight ethnic groups with the least followers of Jesus Christ, has no profile on the Seba. They report that no one is reaching them. There is no Bible in the language of the Seba, and there are no evangelical churches or Christians among these people.

Is the task of finding these people and telling them about Jesus too difficult? Satan would have us believe that there are other things more important. What do you think?

- Pray that God would call out believers to bring the Gospel message to the more than 200,000 Seba of the DRC.
- Pray for the Seba to be spiritually ready to receive these words of truth when these messengers come.
- Pray that as the Seba encounter the God of the universe they would recognize Him as the God of all Gods, the Alpha and Omega, and put their trust in Him.
