The vastness of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), along with the hundreds of people groups therein, make researching the Sonde (SEWN-day) people a challenge. Poor or nonexistent roads in their areas of western DRC are just one obstacle to reaching these people with the Gospel. There are also no Christian resources available, no Bible portions or JESUS film translation in the Sonde language. However, God can make a way in the wilderness. Would you like to stand beside Sonde believers at the throne of God? It will happen, and you can be part of that redemption story.

- Pray for creative minds to uncover ways of logistically getting to the Sonde with the Gospel message.
- Pray for those willing to move out of their comfort zone to a place where there are no phones, Internet, electricity or running water to reach those who have never heard.
- Pray for the Sonde to be spiritually ready to receive the Gospel message.
- Ask God to burden the hearts of believers to pray for the over 150,000 Sonde and other people groups who live in the remote corners of Africa, that they may have a witness of God's grace among them.
