Located in Senegal and Gambia, but expanding into Ivory Coast and Mali, the Wolof (WUL-off) people, numbering close to four million, are mostly Islamic and animistic in their beliefs. Wolof believe in both good and bad spirits as well as witches. Many believe evil spirits live in tall grass and trees, and they wear amulets as a form of protection against them. While there are abundant evangelistic resources available, the Wolof continue to resist the Gospel message. There is a great need for laborers sensitive to the Muslim culture to build relationships among the Wolof and share Christ's love.

- Pray for the light of Truth to shine, unraveling the veil of deception covering Wolof eyes.
- Ask God to call out believers willing to live out their faith among the Wolof.
- Ask God to raise up persons of peace in villages across Senegal and Gambia ready to help messengers of Truth as they come sharing the Gospel.
- Pray the Holy Spirit will move powerfully among the Wolof, confronting sin and revealing their need for a Savior.
- Pray Wolof believers will be protected from persecution and be strong witnesses for Christ.
