Little is known about the Yela (YEH-la) people of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), who number over 86,000. It is known that there are no evangelical churches among the Yela. There is no Bible translation and no access to the Gospel in print, audio or video – the Yela have no avenue to hear the truth. Is this acceptable to you? More importantly, is it acceptable to God? As Christians we have a mandate to “Go into all the world and preach the Gospel” (Mark 16:15). Does that include the Yela, who live in isolated areas of central DRC?

- Pray for God to burden the hearts of people who know the Truth to go share the Truth with Yela men and women, boys and girls who are dying without a Savior.
- Pray for God to prepare “persons of peace” in Yela villages across central DRC so that when messengers come to deliver the Word they will be received and helped.
- Pray for divine appointments from God through dreams and visions, allowing the Yela to already be searching for answers to spiritual questions.
- Ask God to burden believers to partner in prayer for the Yela people.
