The Kambari peoples of Nigeria and Niger are divided into various sub-groups, including the Auna-Agaraiwa. Many in rural areas live in a high state of poverty, with poor to non-existent health care and few educational opportunities.

Kambari witch doctors are perceived to communicate with ancestral spirits for blessings in matters of health, good harvests and other aspects of daily life. Charms are created and worn to ward off sickness and other misfortunes.

Christian resources in this language include Bible portions, audio recordings, JESUS film and video.
