Coloured Creole

“Coloured” designates people of mixed-race who typically have some Sub-Saharan African ancestry, but are not considered Black. It was one of the four officially recognized racial groups during apartheid in South Africa, but the identity still holds today. Many of the Cape Coloured are also descendents of Southeast Asians imported to the region in colonial times as slaves.

The Western Cape region of South Africa has the densest concentration of this people group.
