Many of the Damara work rural farms, each farm being worked by a whole extended family creating a community of up to 100 people. Men hunt and herd cattle, fiercely defending their grazing lands, while the women tend to homes and gardens, milk cows, and raise children. Clan wealth is measured in cattle, with some chiefs holding up to 8,000 head.

Christian resources in this language include the Bible, JESUS film and audio recordings.
