The Gciriku were the first tribal group in the region to accept European missionaries, who were given land in Nyangana. A Catholic mission was established here in 1910, and in Andara in 1913, after six unsuccessful attempts.

Christian resources in Diriku and Rumanyo include New Testament, Bible portions, audio recordings and Scripture recordings.
