Located along Chad's southwest border with the Central African Republic, the Gor live an impoverished lifestyle. They are mostly farmers who grow millet and other cereals, cotton, peanuts, beans and potatoes.

Government health centers have not operated since the war in 1979, and less than half of Gor villages have access to safe drinking water.

While there is some Scripture available, illiteracy rates are high, with only 10 percent able to read and write. Islamic influence is on the rise in the urban areas and among the government. Even so, the Gor are receptive to the Gospel message.

Christian resources in this language include audio recordings.
