The Kotokoli are mainly farmers, living in villages overseen by a ritual headman, usually the eldest man in the community. The Kotokoli are renowned for their shrewd business dealings, and take their name from “koto kolim” – “they give and take back again.” They are also recognized for the pride they take in their ruling chiefs, reciting their lineage and deeds, and praising them with instrumental music.
