The Wandya are a sub-group of the Lambya, who are known for being very hospitable. They usually slaughter and serve a chicken as part of welcoming a visitor, and/or serve *ubughali*, a thick porridge made from maize flour and eaten with sauce or relish. Most would be offended if the visitor refused to eat with them.
